New Servant Infrastructure

After desserts and sweet fellowship, in a Special Called Church Family Conference Sunday night, January 22, the church voted on several important matters.

The Servant Infrastructure of Marble Falls First Baptist Church will be altered slightly to include two types of committees. Four committees will be called **Administrative Committees**. These are Committee on Committees, Personnel Committee, Stewardship Committee, and the First Baptist Christian School Committee. These committees do not typically involve more people than the voted on committee member in completing assigned tasks. Also, these committees typically handle information of a confidential nature and also serve all other committees, teams and staff.

All other committees will be called **Ministry Committees**. These committees will have the freedom to involve more people than their voted members in order to accomplish their tasks.

All of the committees and teams were listed, along with the staff liaison assigned to each one. This information is available, upon request, from the church offices.

Two new Temporary Ministry Committees were also created. The E-Plan Committee consists of following members: Bill Smyrl (Chairman), Mark Few, Richard Slyker, Jake Koziel, Shirley Beaussire and Patricia Roberts. This committee is given the task of implementation of the E-Plan as voted on by the church last fall. This information is available in the church offices. They will help us know how to meet the immediate needs for growth and ministry. The Long Range Planning Committee members are: Bill Smyrl (Chairman), David Cottrell, Larry Cochran, Jim Taylor, Jim Tolles, Deanna Nail, Brett Carter, Mike Williams and Debbie Boling. This committee is given the task of investigation of all possible future building needs of the church, as well as when, where and how any future building should proceed. They will work closely with the pastor, staff, and deacons, as well as others, to determine a consensus on our future building needs.

Please be in prayer for all of our committees and teams. Our main purpose is always to serve our Lord Jesus Christ and bring others to Him. Pray that every ministry, team, committee and activity will help us to accomplish our goal.

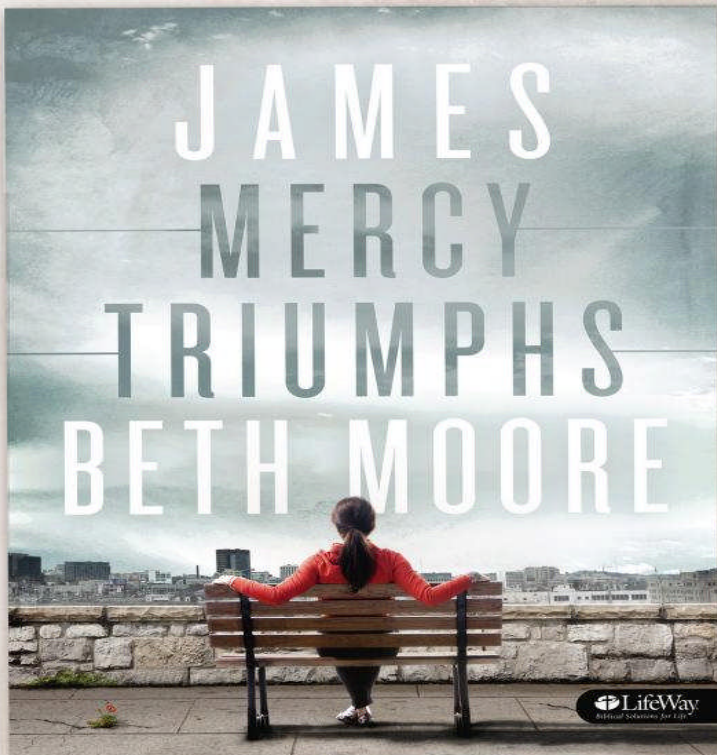

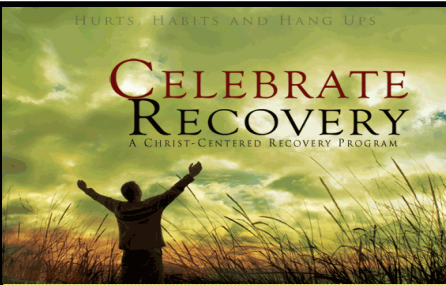
