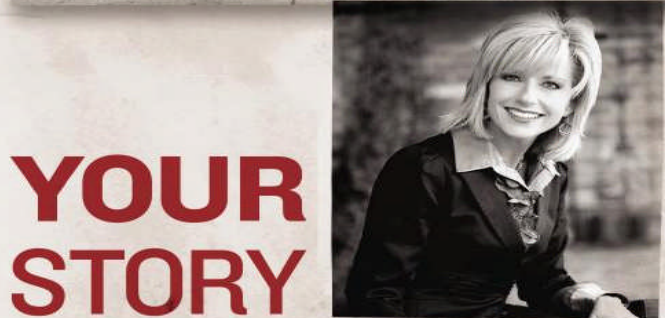
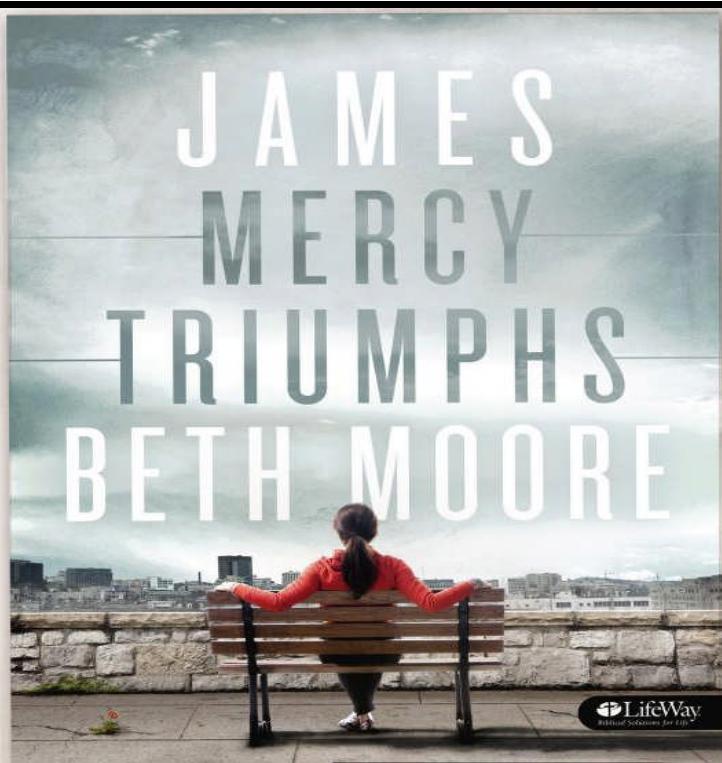

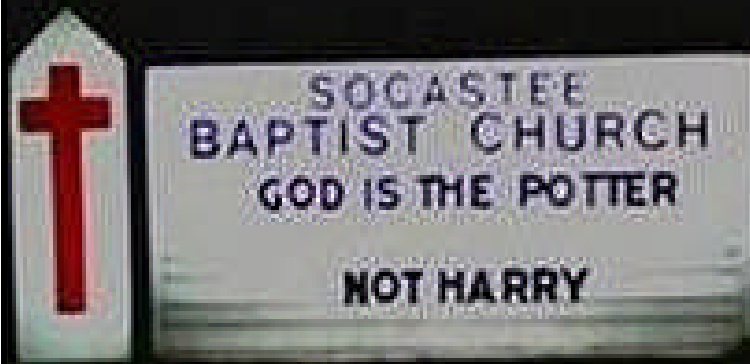

What is Courage?

Items Needed: seven small pieces of paper

Write each letter of the word *courage* on a small piece of paper and hide them around the room when the kids aren't looking. Invite them to find letters to a word that will help them every day. After the letters have been found, unscramble them to make the word *courage*. Tell your children about two men in the Bible—Caleb and Joshua—who had courage. Moses sent 12 spies to search out the Promised Land. Two spies (Caleb and Joshua) gave a good report while 10 spies gave a bad report. The ten said they could not win against the people because they were like giants. But Caleb and Joshua encouraged the people to follow God who would help them win.

Why is it hard to stand up for what's right? (Others might make fun of us, exclude us, fight against us, etc.)

What is courage? (Doing the right thing even though you may feel afraid)

Discuss ways to have courage in the situations below:

- Others are saying bad things about your parents
- Your teacher says that we all evolved
- You did something wrong and your mom asks, "Did you _____?"
- Your friends want to watch a TV show your parents forbid you to watch
- Your friends make fun of someone

It is not always easy to stand up for what is right, but God can give you courage.

4. *Easter at the Auditorium*: Sunday, April 8, 10:30-12noon Easter Egg Hunt to follow on the MFHS Football Field

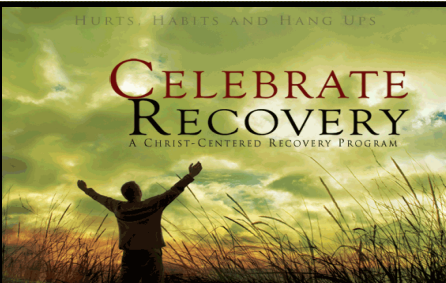
